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The Heart: Valpolicella

But Zenato's narrative is not one to rest on its laurels. The winery's horizons stretched to the Valpolicella area, where the drama of the landscape—with its hills and valleys left by ancient glaciers—mirrors the depth and complexity of Zenato's red wines.

Here, in the Costalunga estate, 35 hectares of land planted at 300 meters above sea level are dedicated to varieties such as Corvina, Corvinone, Rondinella, and Oseleta thrive, crafting the soulful notes of Amarone, a wine that carries the essence of tradition and the mark of a region renowned for its reds.



One of its most sought-after reds is the Amarone Riserva Sergio Zenato. The grapes are selected by plant in the vineyards that are in the municipality of Sant'Ambrogio di Valpolicella. Only experience and an intimate relationship with the vineyard make it possible to understand when a vintage can become Riserva, and each time this intuition gives birth to wines that express unprecedented, original, exclusive emotions. The 1980 vintage is the first to bear the signature on the label. The Reserves, all excellent vintages, are the noblest fruit of the passion with which the Zenato winery cultivates this land and its vineyards.

In addition to its prized Amarone, the winery also produces the Ripassa, a Valpolicella Superiore, re-fermented on the pomace of Amarone. With first vintage released in 1992, it encapsulates Zenato's innovative spirit, creating a bridge between tradition and new expressions of winemaking.
